What is CalFresh?

CalFresh is a federal nutrition assistance program that helps people purchase healthy foods at most grocery stores. Students can receive up to \$291 in benefits monthly. UCI has various academic and professional programs (including all undergraduate programs in the School of Biological Sciences) that students can use to meet their Student Eligibility Requirement for CalFresh!


