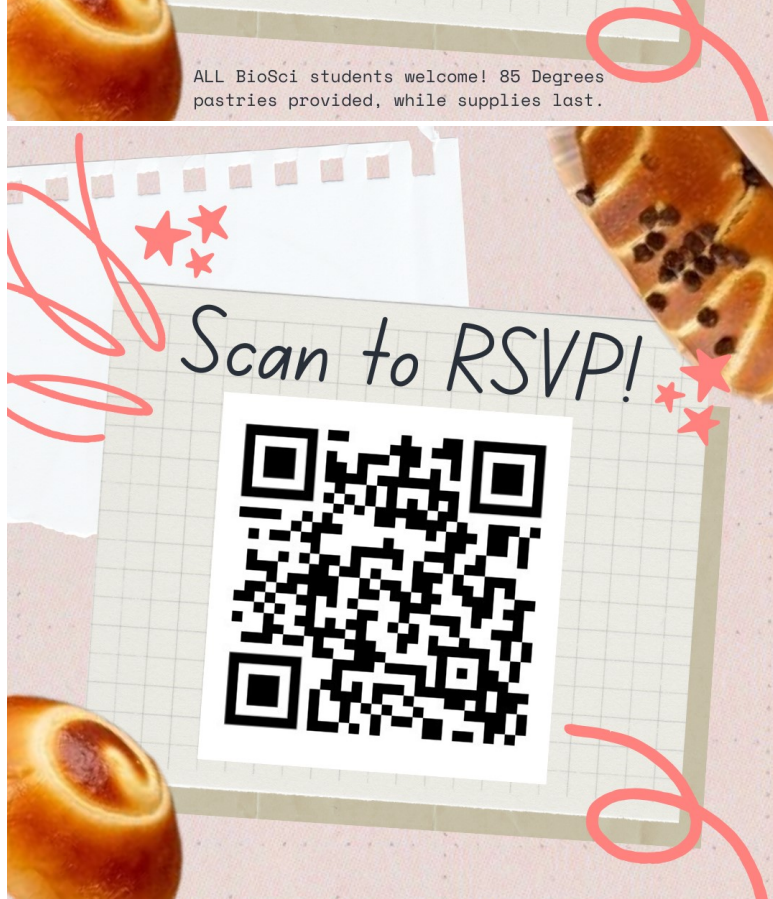
3. Bio Sci PAAs: "Digital Planners/How to Get Organized" Workshop - February 26

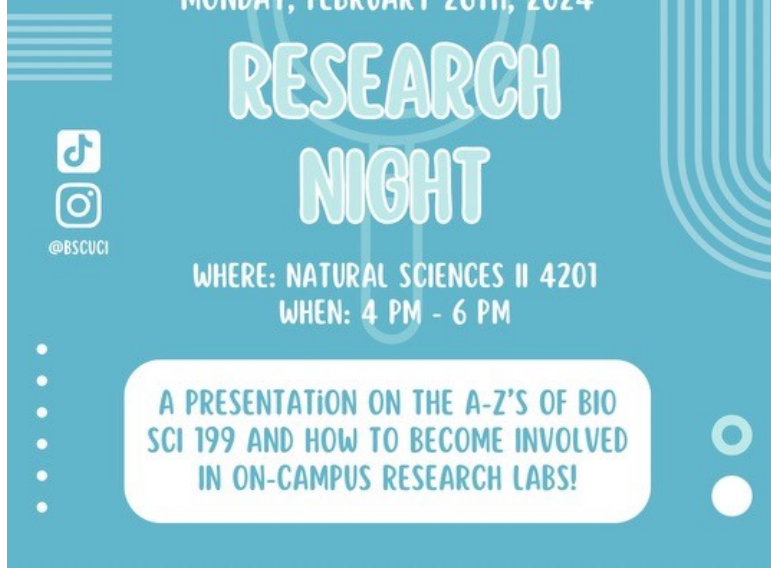
