FINANCIAL ASSISTANCES AND FREE RESOURCES

FOR PRE- HEALTH APPLICANTS

Out of pocket cost can accumulate over time as student prepare and apply for health professions admissions. Many health associations offer some financial support to assist students on this journey. Applicant must demonstrate financial need based on income. Below are key tips and additional resources to assist you.

APPLICATION FEE WAVIERS BASED ON FINANCIAL INCOME

Key Points to Remember

• Apply Early

Financial assistances is issued on a first come first serve basis for eligible applicants that verify financial need. For each application cycle, a **limited** number of waivers are available.

• Not Retroactive

Aid and services are best utilized at the beginning of the application cycle after the applicant has been awarded the benefits. Award is typically not reimbursable.

• **Require Supporting Documents Including Financial Information** Be prepared to provide personal and or parental financial income documentation. This is required to verify financial need to receive aid.

• Expiration

Application fee waivers typically do not carry over and need to be utilized within the current application cycle. Some have a usage timeline of 14 days from the date issued.
