	biology labs. Some schools will require specific biology courses.
General Chemistry	1 year with labs
Organic Chemistry	1 year with labs
Physics	1 year with labs
Math	This varies from one course in college math to a full year of calculus. Most schools will
	require 1 semester or 2 quarters of calculus.
Statistics	Check school requirements for Statistics, UCI and Davis now require it
English	Varies, usually 1 semester to 1 year of English composition
Other?	Each school usually also has a list of recommended courses they like to see.
