## **Dental School Admission Requirements:**

Biology (w/lab)	1 to 1 1/2 years (At UCI Bio 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, *100 minimum). Many schools will					
	require 3 labs. *BioSci 100 is a prerequisite for taking Bio labs at UCI. Some schools					
	will require specific biology courses					
General Chemistry	1 year with labs (at UCI, Chem 1A-B/LB-C/LC or Chem 1A-B-C/LC-LD)					
Organic Chemistry	1 year with labs (at UCI, Chem 51A/LA-B/LB-C)					
Physics	1 year with labs (at UCI Physics 3A-B/LB-C/LC)					
Math	This varies from one course in college math to a full year of calculus. Most schools will					
	require 1 semester or 2 quarters of calculus. (at UCI, Math 2A-B)					
English	Varies, usually 1 semester to 1 year of English composition					
Psychology	Varies, both UCLA and UCSF list an intro class as required					
Other?	Each school usually also has a list of recommended courses.
