# Required for application:

- VMCAS application
- Minimum of 3 electronic letters of recommendation (eLOR)
- Application fee (1<sup>st</sup> application is \$150 in 2013)
- Send directly to veterinary medical schools:
  - o Supplemental application if required, plus associated fees
  - o Official college transcripts (from all post-high school institutions)
  - o Standardized test scores (generally GRE, sometimes MCAT)

**General Application Period:** Early June – Early October. Apply early!

Statistics (Stats 7 or 8)

English composition and additional English (three quarters)

Additional English / literature (two quarters)

Humanities and social sciences (three quarters)

Organic Chemistry with lab (3 sem units)

Biochemistry (3 semester units) – (e.g. Bio 98)

Biological & Life Sciences (9 sem units) (must include 2 upper div courses & 1 upper div lab)

Microbiology (3 sem units) – (e.g. Bio M122)

Physiology (3 sem units)

Genetics (3 sem units) – (e.g. Bio 97)

General Physics with lab (6 sem units)

Statistics (3 sem units) – (e.g. Math 7 or 8)

English Composition (6 sem units)

Humanities/Social Science (9 sem units)

Psychology or sociology (3 sem units) – (e.g. Psych 7A, PsyBeh P9, Sociol 1)

Written communication/science or technology (3 sem units)

Public speaking (3 sem units) – Take at community college

**Recommended/not required**: Courses in anatomy, nutrition and embryology.
